Government Guidelines

Moving school

Moving school is a big deal for any child.

Our experience is that most children cope well with one move. Most children who move to our school experience relief, connection and a feeling of belonging quite soon.

If your child has previously moved school and Citywest ETNS is not your ideal school, we recommend rethinking the proposed move and waiting for your ideal school.

Tell us if...

- Your child has been in receipt of support teaching or SNA/ANA support in their previous school.
- Has ever been excluded or suspended in their previous school.
- You have any other worries about your child settling into their new school.

This will NOT affect their place in our school but WILL allow us to put an appropriate plan in place for them to T them up for success.

The School Day



School for children in Infant classes is 8.25am to 1.05pm. School for children in higher classes is 8.25am to 2.05pm.

We are on a shared campus so assembly and dismissal times are tight. Children should arrive between 8.25am and 8.35am.

The School Day



Children play in the yard for 20 minutes twice per day. They eat a snack before or after yard.

They also have time in the PE Hall, running track, basketball courts, library, outdoor classroom, vegetable garden and support teaching rooms.

How much of that can continue remains to be seen.

Info for Parents



We would usually invite you to a Parent Evening in September. If it is not possible to do this in person, we hope to host it virtually.

Always read emails and texts from the school and make a note of future events or requirements.

The First Day- trust the teacher!

- A nominated teacher will meet your child on the first day and show them how to find their classroom, their teacher and their peers.
- We have a buddy system for children new to the school they will be supported by a friend and a teacher.
- We hope that you (parents) find our community friendly as well - take the courage to say "Hello!" to a fellow parent and to become part of our community!

- Talk about moving school casually without making too big a deal of it. You can look at some videos on our website.
- If your child sees you upset or worried, they will think they should be upset and worried; if your child sees you calm and happy, they will know to be calm and happy.
